



Library Card Registration for Schools

Library cards can be issued to any resident of Clay Township, or to individuals holding Public Library Access Cards. Residents of other library districts in Hamilton County, who present a valid card from their home library, will be granted borrowing privileges from CCPL upon proper application. Identification will be required. A parent's or guardian's signature will be required until a child is in grade 6. Teachers who live outside the library district, but work at schools inside the district and show proof of employment will also be granted borrowing privileges.
